## 2020 Champions Bash Tournaments

### HIGH ROLLER

### PAST CHAMPIONS

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic "The Greater Jacksonville Kingfish Tournament" will follow all Social Distancing Mandated by the Federal, State and Local Governments.

Fishing Date – Monday July 13, 2020

1. All General Tournament rules apply, except as modified below.
2. The prize for the **HIGH ROLLER** tournament will be paid to the **REGISTERED** Captain.
3. All advertised cash prizes are based upon a minimum of 40 paid entries to the High Roller Division and the Tournament reserves the right to adjust the prize structure if there are less or more than 40 paid entries.
4. **Past Champions Tournament:** To Qualify for the Tournament you must be a Past 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winner/Captain. The Qualifying Tournaments are General Tournament Winner (Heavy Fish), General Tournament Aggregate, Single Engine, 23' & Under and VIP. The prize for the **PAST CHAMPIONS TOURNAMENT** will be paid to the Registered Past Champion.
5. In order to qualify for the PAST CHAMPIONS tournament the winning captain must be on board the vessel. The exception being if the captain is deceased, an immediate family member may fish in that past Champion' Honor.
6. No boat can enter the Atlantic Ocean prior to 5:00 AM
7. Hours of fishing are from 6:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., unless terminated earlier by the Tournament's Rules Committee.
8. Only one Kingfish (*Scomberomorus Cavalla*) will be eligible for weigh-in. If you are entered in both tournaments the same fish Will Count for the Past Champions and the High Roller.
9. In the event of a tie in fish weights, the winner shall be determined by the earliest check in time as recorded by the St. Johns River Committee.
10. All boats weighing fish MUST ENTER and check in with the North Side Committee Boat through the St. Johns River inlet, and be west of the North Side Committee Boat by 3:30 p.m.
11. All boats not weighing fish MUST check in with the Committee Boat or by phone (number on front of boat card) or VHF radio (CH 78) by 4:30 p.m. Boats checking in after 4:30 p.m. must do so by phone (number on front of boat card) or VHF radio (CH 78). All Captains must be Checked In by 5:00 p.m.
